ENTRY FEE INCLUDES:

"On-Course" contests, green/cart fees, entry gift, and an option for a "to-go" or "sit-down" luncheon at Roy's Ka'anapali. Awards ceremony will broadcast via YouTube. (Link to be provided). The Legacy Cup Trophy will be awarded to the winning team along with a special grand prize. Other prizes will include resort certificates, golf course certificates, restaurant certificates, golf merchandise and much, much more!

TOURNAMENT FORMAT:

Four-person team scramble with each player required to use a minimum of four (4) of their drives. Team handicap will be based on 25% of the average total team handicap (max handicap for men-24, women-36). Men will play from the white colored tees and women will play from the red colored tees. PGA professionals and players with a handicap of 3 or less will play from the blue tees. Check-in time is 30 minutes before tee time. Your team's assigned tee time will be emailed 48 hours before tournament date. Earliest tee times will begin at 8:00am. Rain or shine. Please maintain physical distancing requirements and wear a facial cover. Active golfers on the course may remove masks while playing so long as physical distancing is being conducted properly. Facial cover must be worn around the facilities when not actively golfing, which includes the Pro Shop, the restrooms and registration table.
